

Pros & Cons of diaper systems

SYSTEM	PROS	CONS
Pockets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - able to control absorbency - quick & easy to put on - wicks moisture away from baby's bottom - come in a variety of colors & prints - very trim - may come in one-size, making less diapers required 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - they need to be stuffed - can be costly - detergent build-up may occur on synthetic liners, which may produce leaks
Diapers & Covers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Less leaks! - the cheapest way - able to control absorbency - natural fibers against baby's skin - covers come in many different styles, colors & prints - easy to wash - you can reuse covers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - take longer to put on - not as trim as pockets/AIOs - synthetic covers are not as breathable as wool or fleece covers - not as easy for other caregivers (daycare)
AIO's All-in-Ones	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the easiest to put on, especially for wiggly kids - most like a disposable; the most user friendly - preferred by daycares 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - takes a long time to dry - unable to control absorbency - increased dry times may wear them out faster
Ai2's All-in-Twos	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - able to control absorbency - the covers can be reused when only the soakers/doublers need changed, requiring less diapers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the doublers must be matched up with coordinating diapers - may be one of the most expensive systems
